Mead lived with the tribes and shares detailed observations of the cultures of each tribe, as well as describing how various personality types fit into each culture.Â The Mundugumor believed that both men and women were 'naturally' aggressive, socially and sexually; impersonal, lacking in tenderness, and competitive. The Tchambuli believed that men were 'naturally' flirtatious, dramatic, and artistic, and that women were 'naturally' domestic, practical, impersonal, and humorous. But these are all ideals, of course. Real people aren't this simple, as individuals or as group members.
